

Where We Work

TINTA works across Latin America, Africa, and Southeast Asia, partnering with Indigenous Peoples, Afro-descendant Peoples, Local Communities, Small-Scale Fishers and other local organisations in tropical forests and high-biodiversity coastal and marine regions.

Strong organisations, stronger communities. We strengthen the institutional capacities of territorial organisations. From operations to long-term planning and leadership development, we provide mentorship, training, and tools that enhance sustainability, resilience, and leadership.

Connecting messages to audiences. We put Indigenous and territorial voices at the centre. Through media, storytelling, and digital campaigns, we raise awareness, share innovations, and connect partners and allies worldwide.

Language inclusion for climate justice. Through multilingual interpretation, translations, and intercultural facilitation, we ensure inclusive participation of territorial leaders in learning, advocacy, and collaborative spaces.
